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Advisory/Warning on Cyclone FANI

The Extremely Severe Cyclonic Storm 'FANI' over West-central Bay of Bengal moved north-northeastwards. The system is likely to further move north-northeastwards and landfall over Odisha coast (India) on 3rd May afternoon.

From this system Bhutan is very likely to receive heavy to very heavy rainfall over the southern, eastern and isolated places of central parts of the country while the rest of the country is likely to receive moderate to heavy rain from 3rd May to 5th May. Gusty wind is also very likely over the country during this period.

Due to very heavy rainfall flashfloods, floods, landslides and windstorms are likely over the eastern and southern parts of the country.

The system is expected to dissipate from 6th May.

Updates will be issued if there are any significant changes in the forecast.
